We also have weighted lap pads and noise reduction headphones. If your child would benefit from the use of any of these items, please let us know.

By registering your child for a library card, you are providing access to a wide variety of information resources in an array of formats. It is not the library's policy to decide what materials your child should be exposed to; therefore, we hope that you will continue to help your child select materials.
