Library Staff: Cindy retired on 11/1. We have an interview scheduled this week to fill the open position. We have a staff meeting on November 17th. Jenny attended the CLNH Fall Conference on October 26th. On December 1st I will attend a workshop for new directors that the State Library is organizing. Goal Two 1c.

Finance: We're 91.67% through the year and have used 77.98% of our budget. The presentation of the proposed 2024 budget to the Select Board went well. Goal One 2bandc and Goal Two 1b.

Library Services: Circulation is up 14% overall compared to last year and across the board—juvenile, adult, and digital. We had 24 new card signups in October.

Programs. Storytime returned from our post-Summer Reading break on September 26th. LR Berger resumed the Flock of New Hampshire Poets series. This program series has developed a loyal following, with many patrons returning monthly. Sarah hosted her first book club on September 27th.
